Notes:

- 1. Sign up no later than 6:00 PM Tuesday each week. This will give us time to set up pairings and determine hole assignments. If for some reason you do not sign up in advance and decide to play, we will attempt to fit you in the weekly competition consistent with the game being played, handicaps, etc. However, there may be occasions where you will be able to play, but not as part of the competition. The \$3 weekly fee will still be collected and you will be eligible for the “closest to the pin” prize. First sign-up sheets will be posted in Mid-March on the Gray Foxes’ bulletin board and weekly thereafter on days of matches.**

 - 2. Please sign-in at least **30 minutes** before start time each week at both the Pro Shop and upstairs in the Eagle’s Nest. Eagle’s Nest sign-in closes 15 minutes before shotgun time. If you sign-in less than 15 minutes before the scheduled tee-off time, it requires a “public penance”.**

 - 3. For individual play formats, assuming sufficient numbers, there will be two flights divided evenly by handicaps.**

 - 4. To be eligible for weekly winnings, you must post all scores that meet USGA posting criteria to the GHIN. Report all scores consistent with Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) rules. Mark Marshall has determined that all holes with temporary greens are to be scored at par plus the handicap strokes you receive for that hole. For Example: if your handicap is 10, you would report a 6 on hole 5 ... par, plus one handicap stroke. If you need assistance, please see Joe Ronan or Mark Marshall. Someone will be checking to ensure rounds are posted. If there is a chronic pattern of “unposted” scores (2 in a row or 2 out of the last 5) you can play but you cannot win prizes.**

 - 5. Please observe the USGA Rules of Golf. The common question asked each week is “How do we play the ball?” The default for 2011 will be: IN THE FAIRWAY -- You may move the ball within one club length, no closer to the hole (lift clean & place): IN THE ROUGH --- play the ball as it lies with one exception. If your ball is on rocks mark the spot clear away the rocks and replace ball in the same place it came to rest. (Note: this is not an opportunity to avoid a tree or other obstruction that does not ordinarily require a free drop)
We will consult with the pro and the greens keeper week-to-week to determine if the default should be modified. We will let you know before teeing off. If we do not announce a change, assume the default is being used.**

 - 6. To avoid any inconsistency or confusion, all putts are to be holed out.**
